You will be able to quickly detect and translate hidden clues that reveal the unseen elements of a person's thinking and emotional patterns of control or lack thereof. Multiple handwriting samples are used to illustrate **Primary Indicators** (D), **Facilitators** (F) and **Inhibitors** (I) of potential violence on every card.

Stroke Description: Long, curved, lead-in strokes, especially at the beginning of words.

Psychological Implications: Often found in handwriting of individuals who are deliberate and who tend to carefully consider possible consequences before making a move. The writer is inclined to consider all the ramifications of his input in a situation and may be more comfortable following old customs and rituals. In the extreme the writer may have a fear of the future and an unwillingness to move ahead with his life. This is a cautious, "look before leaping" indication.

Stroke Description: T bars extended longer than usual. This may include any extended horizontal cross strokes written from left to right.

Psychological Implications: Enthusiasm and enjoyment of ideas and interests. Inner exuberance lends endurance to one's will power, allowing him or her to influence others in either a positive or negative manner, depending on what the enthusiasm is about. The writer is likely to follow through with plans and intentions due to the momentum of the enthusiasm.

D-1 Distorted Personal Pronoun 'I'

Stroke Description: Personal pronoun 'I' that deviates strongly from the copybook model and which does not simplify or make the writing more attractive or more legible. May show as twists, unnecessary loops, breaks, tics, clubs, slashes, x-ing, blotches, unique distortions, weapons. Repeated indications intensify the findings.

D-1 Distorted Personal Pronoun 'I'

Psychological Implications: The personal pronoun 'I' is directly connected to the individual's self-image. Distortions of this letter suggest distortions in one's self-concept. The writer has an odd, unique, or distorted self-image (according to the individual shape, size, etc. of the letter) and may exhibit compulsive behavior patterns. This may indicate talents and unique abilities (when accompanied by positive indicators) or pathological obsessions (when accompanied by negative indications). Philosophies and/or behavior may be altered to serve the writer's own emotional needs.
